entries are received. Crews will automatically be entered in the next higher status event unless otherwise stated at the time of entry. Alternatively, the Committee may offer an event with less than 3 entries as an invitation event with the agreement of the entrants.

Multiple entries will be accepted provided they are clearly marked on the entry form. Doubling up is encouraged, but while every effort will be made, no guarantee can be given regarding race times if competitors enter 3 events. This applies also to sharing coxes or equipment.

The Victor Ludorum will be decided by the results of Finals, with the winners being awarded two points per competitor and runners-up being awarded one point per competitor. The club with the highest total number of points at the end of the regatta will be awarded the Victor Ludorum Prize.
