IMPORTANT NOTES

- In both races a pennant will be awarded to the fastest crew in each event offered. Each member of a winning crew will receive an individual prize. **No overall 'head' prize will be awarded in either race.**
- Entries are also welcome for any four or quad scull event not listed above.
- At least three crews must race in an event for a prize to be awarded.
- Events 4,5,10,11,13,17,18,23 24 and 26 are open to junior competitors aged less than the number specified, e.g. J15 fours are for juniors whose rowing age is less than 15 years.
- Events 13 and 26 are open to male, female and mixed crews. ([SARA Rules of Racing, C13.](#))
- The starting order will be arrived at by reference to the 2002 results. New entrants will be added at the end.
- Competitors can only win at the status for which they are entered.
- All entries must be received by the Entries Secretary by **Monday, 24th November 2003 at 11.00 a.m.**
NO LATE ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- **Entry fees** - £25.00 per senior crew and £20.00 per junior crew (includes S.A.R.A. Levy). **Discounted fees** of £20.00 (senior) and £15.00 (junior) are offered for **payment in full** received **with entries.**
- **Special prizes** of three litres of spirits will be awarded to the **most successful club** at the event and to the **most successful University** at the event. Composite crews do not count towards these prizes.
