

Request for Tenders for Catering and Bar facilities

Strathclyde International Regatta

Scottish Rowing Championships

Any Club wishing to run either the Catering and/or the Bar facilities at the above regattas should apply in writing (hard copy or e-mail) to myself at the address below.

The application should include:

- previous experience of Catering/Bar at SARA regattas,
- the contents and cost of what you would provide as a typical Umpires & stake-boat 'packed lunch',
- prices for the following items : tea, coffee, bacon roll, cold filled roll
- prices for bottled beers 500ml and 330ml, price and measure for spirits
- the donation that you would pay to SARA toward the costs of the marquee and electricity.

Please note the following:

The Catering will be expected to be able to provide a limited service (minimum of tea/coffee & bacon rolls) at least 1 hour before the start of the first race. This is to allow Umpires, Stakeboat personnel etc. to have some form of breakfast before the start of their shift. Full service should be available by the start of the first race. Catering shall remain open until at least 30 minutes after the finish of the last race, and must ensure that there is sufficient provision for Umpires, Stakeboat personnel etc. coming off the water at end of shift. In the event of inclement weather, it is vital that sufficient hot food is available throughout the opening times.

The licence for the Bar will be obtained by the ROC, but the Club running the Bar will be expected to pay the cost of the licence. The licence will be from 11.00am until 8.00pm each day. The bar shall remain open until at least 60 minutes after the finish of the last race, and must ensure that there is sufficient provision for Umpires, Stakeboat personnel etc. coming off the water at end of shift.
