- The first division will commence at 1200
The second division will commence at 1430
- Prizes shall be awarded for the fastest in each category, provided more than 2 crews are competing. There are also trophies for a number of events.
- Veteran events will be raced as 1 category. Final placings will be awarded following handicapping.
- All events shall be run in accordance with SARA rules.
- Entry fees; seniors £5.00 and juniors £4.00 (coxes no entry fee)
- All entry fees must be paid before racing commences. Any entries paid on the day shall be subject to a surcharge of £1.00 per seat.
- Hot drinks and refreshments will be available all day
- The organising committee reserves the right to amalgamate any categories for which there are single entries. Amalgamation will be upwards to the next category eg R2 to open, novice to R2.
