Information for Competitors

Trailer Parking

Trailers and sculls on top of cars must be parking in the grassy area off the car park as marked on the course map. All rigging should be done in this area, and not in the car park. Please be aware of other people when walking boats to and from the trailer park. Boats must be returned here when not being raced, and should be left securely fastened to trailers on in a stable position on the ground.

Cars may be parked in the Outdoor Centre car park or the main Lochore Meadows car park.

Registration

All crews must register at least one hour prior to racing. Crew numbers will be available at registration on receipt of all entry fees. Any changes to crews (such as scratching or substitutions) should be done at registration. Any members not in possession of a current racing licence should request a day ticket at that time.

Boating

There are two pontoons. The southern pontoon will be for out-going crews only, the northern pontoon for incoming crews only. Any crew requiring to swap personnel on the incoming pontoon must inform race control prior to boating.

Circulation pattern from the pontoons must be adhered to at all times.

Finish area

The area directly behind the finish is very shallow. All crews must stop immediately after the finish line and turn towards the landing area.

Facilities

There is a cafe at Lochore Meadows, open from 10.30am to 4pm. There will also be food and drink available near Regatta Control.

There are toilets at both the Outdoor Centre and main Lochore Centre. Please be aware that there are building works at the Outdoor Centre and take appropriate precautions.

Safety Launch

There will be a safety launch on duty at all times. Start and Finish umpires will be in radio contact with the launch and the bank.

Prize Giving

Prize giving will take place shortly after the conclusion of racing.

Directions to Lochore

From the M90 (Edinburgh/Glasgow)

Leave the M90 at junction 2A (signposted Glenrothes, Kirkcaldy), then merge onto the A92 and branch left (signposted Lochgelly). At crossroads turn left onto the B9149 and at roundabout take the 2nd exit onto the B9149.

At the roundabout take the 1st exit onto Auchterderran Road - B981 (signposted Lochgelly, Ballingry) and continue forward onto Auchterderran Road - B981. Entering Lochgelly, at T-junction turn right onto the B920 and continue forward onto the B920. Entering Ballingry at mini-roundabout continue forward onto the B920 to Lochore. Lochore Meadows Country Park is signposted to the left.

When you arrive at Lochore Meadows, please park all trailers and car topped boats in the trailer park (as shown on the course map).
