**Course**

The course will be from the straight upstream of Dalmarnock Bridge to level with the Nelson Monument in Glasgow Green, a distance of 4000m approximately. The organizing committee reserve the right to change the course length if competitor safety requires it.

There will be two races for Eights and Coxed Fours, the first starting at 12:00am and the second at 2:30pm.

**Awards**

The Gibson Quaich will be awarded to the HOR Fastest Mens crew in Race B. Individual Pennants will be awarded to the winners of each status.

Clubs who have winning crews in Fastest Overall and Junior U18 categories, for both the open and women, will receive an extra pennant.

Winning crews will receive a Certificate and prize sponsored by V.Ships U.K. on the race day, and will have a pennant posted to them shortly after. No crew can win more than one category per race. A minimum of 2 crews is required to receive a prize.

## **Veteran**

The Veteran Division will be run with the standard SARA handicapping system. Please specify to which category crews belong, on the entry form. Status specified in the entry form will be the one used in the race, unless by prior agreement with the Regatta Secretary. Finish position in the Head overall will not be affected by the handicapping system.

## **Starting Order**

Start Order will be drawn in event status.

## **Entry Fee**

The entry fee will be: £40 per eight and £32 for Juniors, £20 per four and £16 for Juniors, all inclusive of SARA levy. In addition, a £5 deposit will be required for the crew numbers. If possible, please include deposit with entry fee cheques. The deposit will be returned when race control receives the crew numbers after the race.

*The entry form must include a Licence Number for every competitor – No Licence means No Racing!*

## **Junior Men/Women**

JU 14 & 15 will be combined if there are insufficient entries in each category.

Junior events are now held in either Open or Women's categories (Rule E7). Junior women can now enter the Junior event for men either as whole crews or in male/female crews in any combination. Crews in Women's Junior events must be all female.

## **Cancellation**

You will be invoiced on any/all entries that are cancelled unless notice is received 48 hours prior to race day.

## **Closing Date**

Entries including entry fees should be received at the address below no later than 4 pm on **Sunday the 26<sup>th</sup> February 2006**.
