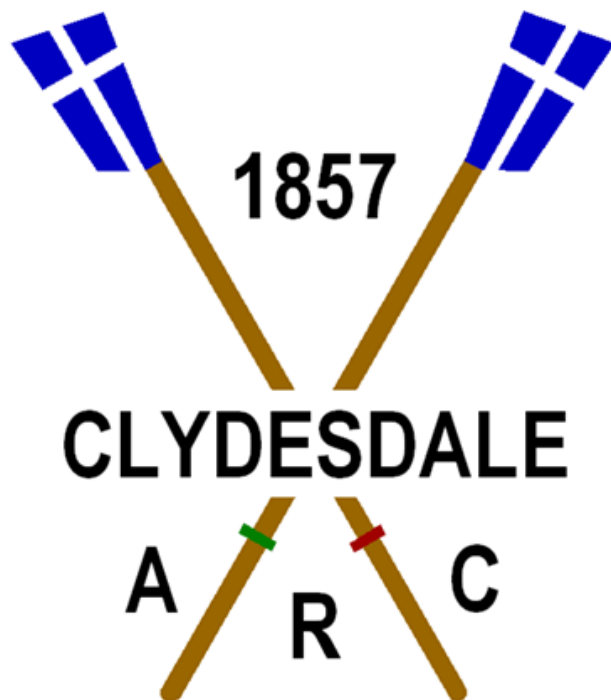

SARA Water Safety Code

All competitors should be familiar with the SARA Water Safety Code and should note especially the following safety requirements.

- All boats must be water worthy including bow balls and foot restraints
- All coxes must wear lifejackets

Those not meeting these requirements will be unable to compete on the day.

Rules for Entries

The Regatta Committee reserves the right to cancel any event with less than 3 entries. Where there are insufficient entries in one event, a crew or sculler may be moved to the next event unless **instructed specifically** not to. For Veteran events, a handicapped event may be offered.

Multiple Entries (for competitors OR equipment) MUST be clearly marked on the entry form. Double entries will be accepted but it is the responsibility of competitors to meet the start times. Triple entries must be prioritised and will only be accepted at the discretion of the regatta committee.
