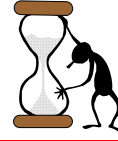


CSRC Regatta - Conditions of entry



Note new closing date!!

1. The regatta will take place at Castle Semple Loch, Lochwinnoch on Saturday 19th May 2007.
2. All races will be rowed in accordance with SARA rules.
3. All races will be 1000m except where specified in the "list of events". The course is straight, multi-laned and fully buoyed.
4. All competitors must hold a valid **Racing Licence** at date of entry, or purchase a **Day Ticket**. The licence will need to be presented to the Regatta Organising Committee prior to collecting a prize.
5. **Entry fees** are: £6 for seniors, £4 for juniors, coxes are free (this includes the SARA levy). There will be a 10% discount on total fees in excess of £200. *(Note these fees are unchanged from 2006 !!)*
6. Entries can be posted or emailed using our entry form. It is important that the certificate on the entry form covering affiliation and buoyancy is signed in every case. Cheques must accompany a postal entry or follow an email entry.

ENTRIES CLOSE: 9pm on **Friday 11th** May 2007.

(Yes, we do mean Friday to enable us to time-table the draw.)

8. Cheques should be made payable to "CSRC" (Please - one cheque per club).

9. **The draw will take place on Saturday 12th and Sunday 13thth May 2007.** Please provide a contact phone number where we are able to contact you over that week-end while the draw is taking place. The draw will be available from Wednesday 16th May 2007.
10. Where insufficient entries are received to run an event the organizing committee will enter the crew in the next highest status unless otherwise requested.
11. The Committee aim to run single category **veteran events** where practical. Failing that, races will be constructed within a **maximum of 3 adjacent category spread**. These events will be run according to the SARA handicapping system and the standard handicapping tables will be used.
12. Double entries are encouraged. Three or more entries will be accepted but with no guarantee of a rest period.
13. **All multiple entries must be clearly marked on the entry form.** The organizing committee will take no responsibility for time clashes where doubling has not been clearly indicated.
14. It is the entering clubs responsibility to ensure they have **sufficient boats** to support their entry and that all boats they use at the regatta comply with the **buoyancy clause** now incorporated within the Water Safety Code adopted by the SARA
15. Committee boats may be available. The use of such boats must be requested prior to the draw and should be clearly marked on the entry form.
16. Coxes **must** wear a lifejacket.
17. Competitors **must** adhere to the circulation pattern (issued with the draw).
