



Following the most recent meeting of the SARA Performance Planning Group (PPG) the following senior athletes have been invited to final trials, for the Scotland 2007 Home International Regatta Team, on the 28<sup>th</sup> of April. Athletes selected should monitor the International Rowing pages of the SARA website for further details of the final trial.

All athletes invited for final trial have demonstrated performances in excess of 79% of the predicted world gold medal time, deemed by the PPG to be the minimum standard for inclusion at the final trial. Athletes providing medical evidence for not meeting this standard at the February trial were required to have demonstrated recent performances in excess of this standard prior to the trial.

Athletes who have taken part in the selection process to date may still be eligible for inclusion in the Home International team should they be able to demonstrate performance improvement to the level required in races against selected athletes. Athletes are particularly encouraged to compete at the Strathclyde Park Regatta and Scottish Championships.

Athletes and coaches should be aware that appeals can only be made once the final team has been selected.

Junior athletes will be selected based on performances at the February trial and at the Strathclyde Park Regatta. Junior coaches are asked to wait until details of the structure of the "trial" at the Strathclyde Park Regatta have been published before making their entries. This information will be made available to coaches before Wednesday the 21<sup>st</sup> of March.

The management team would like to thank all athletes who put themselves forward for selection. In addition thanks go to all coaches who assisted in running the latest trial.
